**HAVE YOU OBTAINED OR RENEWED  
YOUR DOG(S) LICENCE FOR THIS YEAR?**

All dog owners, having dogs six months of age  
or older are required to purchase a Licence in  
January of each year.

No dog may be Licenced unless the owner produces at the time of application, a valid rabies certificate to buy your dog Licence. Please purchase your Licence in January of each year.

**Be a part of the solution  
Spay or Neuter your pets**

**Dogs running at large are in contravention to the By-Law and may result in the dog owner being charged and/or dog being impounded.** If the dog is impounded and has a Licence, the Humane Society will notify the owner to have their dog picked up within four days.

Please DO NOT ABANDON your animals,  
the Humane Society will accept them without  
judgement.

## **DOG LICENCES**

2018 Dog Licences are now available. Your rabies tag is not a City of Sarnia Dog Licence. City of Sarnia tags are silver aluminum.

**If you purchase your tag between  
January 1<sup>st</sup> until March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018**

Altered Female or Male	\$36.00
Unaltered Female or Male	\$82.00
Dangerous Dog(as designated by the City)	\$375.00

**If you purchase your tag "AFTER"**  
**March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018**

Altered Female or Male	\$62.00
Unaltered Female or Male	\$110.00
Dangerous Dog(as designated by the City)	\$400.00

Sarnia City Hall first floor, Customer Service

**Please bring proof of rabies vaccination and  
proof of alterations when applying for a  
dog Licence.**

**Please note that, only two dogs per household  
are permitted, without obtaining a Municipal  
Waiver.**
