

Electricity Supply Mix



Under Ontario Regulation 416/99, Bluewater Power Distribution Corporation is required to disclose the system-wide electricity supply mix to all standard supply service customers in its service area. The electricity supply mix is the combination of electricity sources used to generate the electricity that is consumed in Ontario.

The Ministry of Energy has provided a chart showing the electricity supply mix for 2017 for electricity suppliers. For details, please refer to the other side of this bill insert.
